
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Muscat Stock Exchange

MSX Index <.MSX30> closed at 4,652.080 point. Attempts to break below the 2-years ascending trend line has been seen in the last couple of weeks, while a firm close below it is expected to trigger a fall back to the strong support level at 4,470 point. On the positive side, a break above the first overhead resistance line at 4,720 point should enhance further buying momentum and increase the chances of reaching the high of this year at 4,865 point, while above this would lead to 5,048 point.

Long-term investors can stay in the market with a stop-loss below 4,470 point, while medium-term investors can re-enter the market at levels higher than 4,720 point.

Price closed at OMR0.370. Once again, the support line at around OMR0.350 prevented additional weaknesses and allowed some buying momentum to take place but the price remains below all MAs on the weekly chart; however, a close above OMR0.400 would be the first improvement sign that should enhance further gains to OMR0.450. On the other side, a fall below OMR0.350 would lead to the strong support line at OMR0.314.

Price closed at OMR0.340. The stock has seen a noticeable bullish move, reaching levels last seen in April-2018, knowing that a cross over the recent high at OMR0.380 would call for another leg up towards OMR0.460 and maybe higher to OMR0.513. However, some downward natural correction could take place due to the overbought status of the weekly RSI indicators, knowing that a fall below OMR0.295 would lead to OMR0.255.

Price closed at OMR0.075. The stock is back to the negative territory and eyes now have shifted to the horizontal line at OMR0.067, which should arrest further losses but a dip below it would lead to the critical support line at OMR0.057. On the counter side, back above OMR0.081 is expected to decrease the downside risk and bring back to focus the resistance level at OMR0.090.



Al Anwar Ceramics

Price closed at OMR0.175. The stock has been trading within the range of OMR0.149-OMR0.205 for more than 10-months and needs to escape out of this to turn the picture brighter, knowing that a fall below OMR0.149 is expected to lead to OMR0.109. However, managing to surpass OMR0.205 along with an increase in trading activity should target the resistance level at OMR0.285.



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Definitions

Technical Analysis: Aims to identify the direction of prices and reveal any indication of possible changes as soon as possible, so it can be used as much as possible in making buying and selling decisions in the most appropriate time in order to minimize risk and maximize profits.

Trend: The general direction of a market or of the price of an asset.

Resistance: A chart point or range that caps an increase in the level of a stock or index over a period of time.

Support: The price level which, historically, a stock has had difficulty falling below. It is thought of as the level at which a lot of buyers tend to enter the stock.

Breakout: A signal that prices are beginning to trend, either upward or downward.

Bull: An investor who thinks the market, a specific security or an industry is likely to rise.

Bear: An investor who thinks the market, a specific security or an industry is likely to decline.

Channel: is two parallel trend lines either rising or declining.

Consolidation Area: is a sideways movement in prices that interrupts or reverse a trend.

Moving Average (MA): The most common applications of MAs are to identify the trend direction and to determine support and resistance levels.

MACD (Moving Average Convergence-Divergence): A trend-following momentum indicator that shows the relationship between two moving averages of prices.

Relative Strength Index: A technical momentum indicator (ranges from 0 to 100) that compares the magnitude of recent gains to recent losses in an attempt to determine overbought and oversold conditions of an asset.

Overbought: A situation in which the price of a security has risen to such a degree that an oscillator has reached its upper bound. This is generally interpreted as a sign that the price of the asset is becoming overvalued and may experience a pullback.

Oversold: A situation in which the price of a security has fallen to such a degree that an oscillator has reached its upper bound. This is generally interpreted as a sign that the price of the asset is becoming undervalued and may represent a buying opportunity for investors.

Fibonacci: A term refers to areas of support or resistance and to help identify strategic places for transactions to be placed, target prices or stop losses.

On Balance Volume (OBV): is a simple running total of up day (added) and down day (subtracted) volume. If OBV is moving with price, it confirms the current trend. Divergences between OBV and price indicates the price may be due for a reversal.

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
